Announcement of Funding for 2009

The 1772 Foundation has announced that \$350,000 will be made available for preservation trades and crafts schools and programs in 2009.

It is anticipated that 7-18 grants will be made in the \$10,000-50,000 range.

All organizations who wish to be considered should submit a letter of inquiry on or after the 15th of September, 2008 through the foundation's website at www.1772foundation.org

The letter should reference announcement PTC2009.

Not all letters of inquiry will result in an invitation to submit a full application.

Applications may be invited for submission in December 2008, April 2009, or July 2009.

To be eligible to apply, organizations must have a 501c3 IRS designation.

The foundation is most interested in projects that promote education in traditional building trades and crafts; projects that include a restoration project component for another 501c3 organization; those that involve at-risk populations; and those that work in inner cities.
